SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ANNOUNCEMENT AND JURISDICTION

The Wirral Hundred Motor Club will hold Classic Parades at Anglesey Racing Circuit, Ty Croes, Anglesey on 29th & 30th July 2017, under the above Permit granted by the ACU. The Meeting is held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations for Road Races (Section 20.4 – PR6 Classic Machine and / or Rider Parades), these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions subsequently issued or Official Announcements made.

3. RIDER & MACHINE ELIGIBILITY

1. Riders under 70 years of age must hold a current ACU Road Race Competition Licence, a current ACU Road Race Parade Licence or a Class A DVLA motorcycle licence. Participants (including sidecar passengers) who are 70 years of age or over must hold an ACU Parade Licence or a current Road Race Competition Licence.
2. The minimum age for participation in Parades is 14 years. Where a participant is under the age of 18 years a Parental Consent Form must also be completed.
3. All participants must complete an Entry Form Declaration using the standard ACU wording for participation in Road Racing.
4. Riders with Licences from other FMN's must produce valid Start Permission and Medical Repatriation to at least FIM standards. (Please hand a hard copy to the Secretary of the Meeting on signing on).
5. Riders must be members of an ACU affiliated club

4. ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the Official Form and sent to the Parade Secretary

Please send a Stamped Addressed Envelope. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry.

5. ENTRY FEES AND INSURANCE PREMIUM

(1) Entry Fee - £40 – for one day: £60 for two days.

The organisers undertake to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him against third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrants, sponsors or mechanics.

- (2) Unless sufficient entries are received the Promoters may cancel the event. Any event or the whole of the Meeting may be abandoned should circumstances arise which in the opinion of the Promoters render such course desirable.

6. THE COURSE

The 'Coastal' Course will be used.
Direction is clockwise. Maximum number of starters: 60.

ENTRY DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:-

- I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so.
I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event I am entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU permitted competition nor on the ACU Stop List as a result of incurring a Concussion Injury.
- I accept that insurance arranged on my behalf by the organisers of events that I may enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in a high risk activity.
- I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course.
- I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
- I confirm that the machine(s) as described overleaf which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose.
I confirm that I am eligible to participate on the machines for which I have entered.
- I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described overleaf shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
- I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.

Acknowledgement of the risks of motorsport: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I have read the above and acknowledge that my participation in motorsport is entirely at my own risk.
