1. ANNOUNCEMENT AND JURISDICTION

The Wirral Hundred Motor Club will hold four European Open Road Race Meetings for Solo Motorcycle & Sidecar Machines at Anglesey Racing Circuit, Ty Croes, Anglesey, on 21st March, 31st May, 24th & 25th July, 2nd & 3rd October, 2010 under the above Permits granted by the ACU. The Meetings are held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations for Road Races and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions subsequently issued or Official Announcements made.

3. ELIGIBILITY

All Competitors must be Registered Members of Clubs affiliated to the Cheshire & North Wales Centre ACU. To be able to take part in this competition all riders and passengers must be in possession of a current ACU, SACU or FMN EUROPEAN Competition Licence for Road Racing. Holders of licences issued by any FMN other than the ACU or the SACU must have insurance from the relevant FMN. This insurance must include the FIM Standard Repatriation and evidence of such insurance will need to be seen by the Secretary of the Meeting. (Wirral Hundred Membership if required - £10)

4. ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the Official Form and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting

and must be received no later than the dates shown on the entry form. **PLEASE SEND A SAE.** Riders are strongly advised to post their entries early, as the list will be closed on the closing dates or when sufficient entries per class have been received, whichever is the earlier. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry.
Reserves:- Riders accepted as reserves can withdraw their entry only if the Secretary of the Meeting is notified within 96 hours of the posting of such acceptance by the organisers. If there are insufficient vacancies to enable a reserve to ride he will have his entry fee refunded. Reserves will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

5. ENTRY FEES AND INSURANCE PREMIUM

- (1) **Race Meetings** as per Entry Form **Test Day - Solos £90 & Sidecars £95** will be taken on day.
The organisers undertake to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrants, sponsors or mechanics.
- (2) Unless sufficient entries are received the Promoters may cancel the event. Any event or the whole of the Meeting may be abandoned should circumstances arise which in the opinion of the Promoters render such course desirable. Only in exceptional circumstances affecting a particular rider will entry fees (less an administration charge of **£15.00**) be refunded – no refunds will be considered unless the Secretary of the Meeting is notified in writing at least two days prior to the meeting and the entry passes returned therewith.

6. THE COURSE

The 'Coastal' Course (1.55 miles to the lap) is to be used for the first 3 meetings and the 'International' Course (2.1 miles to the lap) for the final meeting of the year.
Race direction will be Clockwise.
Maximum number of starters: Solos 40 (practice 60); Sidecars 30 (practice 45).

7. PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

Class 1 – Formula 125

Class 2 – 125cc GP

Class 3 – 250cc GP

Class 4 – Minitwins

Class 5 – Formula 400

Class 6 – Formula 600 (inc Steel-Framed)

Class 7 – Powerbikes (**machines over 600cc**)

Class 8 – Classic bikes

Class 9 – Forgotten Era up to 500cc **pre 31.12.1989**

Class 10 – Forgotten Era over 500cc **pre 31.12.1989**

Class 11 – Open Sidecars

Depending on the level of entries for each class, heats and finals may be run, further details in the Final Instructions. Classes may also be amalgamated. The race lengths will depend on the number of entries received. However it is planned that each class will have two races in March & May (6/8 laps), three races in July (6/8 laps) and four races in October (5/6 laps). The Club has its own criteria for Minitwins and Forgotten Era machines, available on our website and on request from the Secretary of the Meeting.

8. AWARDS ON THE DAY

Awards in the form of cups or plaques will be given for either one or two specified races for each class at each meeting. The number of awards will depend on the numbers in each class.

9. The WIRRAL HUNDRED MOTOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

Points system: 15 - 12 - 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1. (For Class 1 - 4 & 8 - 11).

25 - 20 - 16 - 13 - 11 - 10 - 9 - 8 - 7 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1. (For Class 5, 6 & 7).

Our four meetings at Anglesey and two at Oulton Park to count.

The second round of races (second & third on 2nd & 3rd Oct) will decide championship positions.

In addition to the above classes, there are separate championships for Steel Framed 600's and F2 Sidecars.

Annual awards to at least the first three in each class, provided the entry levels justify this.

10. REPORTING

Technical Verification will commence at 8.00am. Riders will not be permitted to practice until their machine and protective clothing have been passed by a Technical Official. Riders and passengers must sign on with the Secretary of the Meeting before 10.00am after technical verification and before commencing practice.

Licences must be produced when signing on and any rider or passenger unable to produce his/her licence will only be permitted to start at the discretion of the Stewards in a meeting and may be liable to a fine not exceeding £10.00.

10a - On Test Days technical verification is the responsibility of each Competitor.

11. TRANSPONDERS **All machines must be fitted with a Transponder.**

12. PRACTICE

Practice will take place between 10.00am and 12.00noon. Practice will be of 15 minute sessions.

The timetable and order of practice will be in the Final Instructions, being determined by the entries received.

13. GRID POSITIONS

Championship positions and known ability will determine up to the first four rows in the first round of solo races, with the remaining rows determined by ballot.

The grid for the first sidecar race will be determined by timed practice.

The finishing order in the first round of races will determine the grid positions for the remainder of the meeting.

14. START OF A RACE

A red signal light will be displayed for up to five seconds. The red light will go out to start the race.

Or the National Flag will be lowered. All races will have clutch starts.

15. FINISH OF A RACE

The Chequered flag will be displayed as the winner crosses the finishing line. The criteria for establishing the finishing order and the number of finishers is as set out in the ACU Standing Regulations.

16. TYRES - Slick tyres are only permitted for Classes 2, 3, 7 & 11

17. TEST DAY

Arrangements have been made for testing on Saturday 20th March (Commencing 11.00am).

It is open only to ACU Road Race Licence holders, and will be held under the 2010 ACU Standing Regulations for Test Days.

Booking not necessary – but Signing On is obligatory. Test Day programme will be advised on the day.

18. 'ANGLESEY GRAND'

The meeting on 2nd / 3rd October incorporates the 'Anglesey Grand'. Invitations to this will be based on known ability and on performances on 2nd October.

3. ELIGIBILITY

All Competitors must be Registered Members of Clubs affiliated to the Cheshire & North Wales Centre ACU. To be able to take part in this competition all riders and passengers must be in possession of a current ACU, SACU or FMN EUROPEAN Competition Licence for Road Racing. Holders of licences issued by any FMN other than the ACU or the SACU must have insurance from the relevant FMN.
